Our College had a humble beginning in 1970. It was started with just 7 teachers and 84 students. Now it has grown into a First-grade College with a total student-strength of 2803 (849 boys and 1954 girls), 111 members of the teaching staff and 52 members of the non-teaching staff.

Faculty Improvement and Career Development

Dr.S. Ganeshram, Associate Professor of History and Dr.M. Sakthi Saradha, Assistant Professor of Commerce were awarded their doctoral degrees this year by the Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai. The NAAC Peer Team visited our Institution on the 11th, 12th of 13th of April 2012 for reaccreditation and reaccredited it with 'A'.

Scholarship

1371 students of both the aided and the unaided streams have received a sum of Rs.21,93,782/- as scholarship. Of this, 780 students have received Rs.9,36,917/- from the Backward Classes Welfare Department and 348 students have got Rs.6,82,365/- from the Adi Dravidar Welfare Department. 244 students have received a sum of Rs.5,69,500/- as educational aid from the “Farmers Welfare Scheme” of the Government of Tamil Nadu. Ms.S. Ezhail Manobala, I M.Sc., Chemistry has received Rs.1,500/- from the Tamilnadu Chief Minister Scheme and Mr.S. Karuppasamy, III B.A, History has got Rs.3,500/- as Gandhi Memorial Special Scholarship.

Other Educational Aids

Under the auspices of “Sri S.R. Naidu Education, Culture and Charity Endowment” instituted by late Srimathi Thayammal, wife of the name – founder of our College, a cash prize of Rs.1,000/- is awarded to students who secure first-place in each academic discipline every year.

Vasan S. Ramasamy Naicker Cash Prize of Rs.1,000/- each is awarded by his daughter Mrs.R. Sumathi, Assistant Professor of English of our College, and her family members to 20 poor students

Thiru L. Krishnamoorthy M.A. B.Ed. Memorial Endowment Prize of Rs.1,000/- each is awarded by his son Mr.K.G.S. Ramanan, Head of the Department of Business Administration of our College to 15 poor students.

Physics Alumni Endowment Scholarship of Rs.25,000/- is awarded to meritorious students of U.G. and P.G. Physics students of our College this year.

Dr.G. Veerakumaran of Kerala Agriculture University instituted an Endowment in his name this year. Out of this Endowment a cash prize of Rs.1,000/- will be awarded to the student who secures the First place in M.Phil., Commerce every year.

“Thiru P. Madhavan Memorial Endowment Prize was instituted by his son Mr.M. Sundararajan, one of the first batch (1983-1985) of M.Com. students, this year. A cash prize of Rs.5,000/- is to be awarded to the students who secure first place and Rs.2,500/- to the students who secure second place in B.Com., B.Com. C.A. and M.Com., from this year onwards.

Gold medals are being awarded to the Best Boy Student and the Best Girl Student by Sri T.G. Krishnamoorthy, a Chennai – based industrialist. A gold medal for the Most Pious Student is awarded by Sri Sai Pathuga Trust, Madurai every year.

College Management Endowment Prizes

Gold medals to the I rank, cash prizes of Rs.1,000 to the II rank holders and cash prizes of Rs.500 to students who secure any rank at the University level are awarded by our College Management every year.

Hostel

Our College has two hostels one for boys and the other for girls. The Boys Hostel at present has 179 inmates, 87 from our College and 92 from our Polytechnic and the Girls Hostel has 367 inmates, 364 from our College and 3 from our Polytechnic. The Deputy Warden Dr. S. Venkatasamy and a team of resident wardens are taking care of the needs of the hostellers.

Physical Education

Our College celebrated its 42nd Sports Day on the 17th February 2012 in a grand manner. Mr. M. Marimuthu, III B.A., History and Ms. N. Divya, III B.Sc. (Chemistry) became the College Champions. This year too our boys and girls participated in various sports competitions conducted at the University and the Inter University levels and achieved distinctions..

Mr. M. Rabisandilian, II M.C.A. was selected for the University Chess Team and participated in the South Indian Inter University Chess competitions held at VIT, Vellore.

Our special appreciation is for Mr.G. Suguna Prakash I M.Sc., Computer Science who got First Place in the University Weight Lifting Competition in 56 kg. level and Mr.A. Murugesan, II B.Com. who got III place in the 69 kg. level.

National Service Scheme

Our College has five NSS Units - three for boys and two for girls -which are guided by the Programme Officers Dr. R. Radhakrishnan, Dr. K. Navaneethakrishnan, Mr. G. Balaji, Ms. S. Manju and Ms.S. Vijayalakshmi. The NSS volunteers have been very active in rendering social service. The Girls' Units organized a seven-day special camp at O. Mettupatti and Othayal Villages from 8.3.2012 to 14.3.2012. The Boys' Units organized a seven-day camp at Chatrapatti, Sadayampatti and Chinnakollapatti villages from 9.3.2012 to 15.3.2012. Programmes such as pollution control, environmental protection, eye donation and blood donation, communal harmony awareness and tree plantation were taken up at the villages where the camps were conducted .

342 girl and 60 boy NSS volunteers attended the Sri Ramakrishna and Swami Vivekanandha Devotees 19th State level Conference organized by Sri Ramalinga Mills Ltd., Aruppukottai from 2.12.2011 to 4.12.2011 and rendered their valuable service to the devotees and earned their high appreciation.

A blood donation camp was conducted on 6.1.2012 on our campus. 103 volunteers donated their blood to the blood bank of the Government Hospital, Virudhunagar. 25 girl volunteers attended a Polio drops camp at Sattur on 20.2.2012.

Placement Cell

Under the able guidance of Mr. K.G.S. Ramanan, the Placement Cell of our College, has been training and coaching students to make them employable. In this academic year (2011-12), 40 students of our College received placement orders from leading companies such as the Tech Mahindra Satyam, Chennai, Institute of Language Management (ILM), Bangalore, Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Chennai, HCL BSERV Software Systems, Chennai, WIPRO Software Solutions, Chennai, Appasamy Associates, Chennai, and Krishna Advanced MRI Scans Ltd., Trichy & Villupuram.

During this academic year the Placement Cell, in coordination with the Career Guidance Cell and other departments, conducted Numerical and Technical Aptitude training programme, Entry in Services training programme, a workshop on Technical and Aptitude test and Personality Moulding Session for the benefit of our students.

Women's Forum

The Women's Forum of our College, working with the objective of empowering and sensitizing the girl students, who are the majority, in the College to the women's issues, has organized a series of programmes on the campus. Noteworthy among them is the Pongal Day Celebrations held on 13th January, 2012. Competitions such as Rangoli, Jumbled letters, Dumb Charade, Memory Testing and Recitation of Tirukkural were conducted, in association with the Departments of English and Tamil.

With a view to creating awareness among the girls on Internet Applications, it organized a guest lecture by Ms.Rathnabala of CSC Academy on 30th January, 2012. An Awareness Programme on Acupuncture with Dr.T.Kannan of Tirupur as the Chief Guest was held on 17th February, 2012. A two-day workshop on Vegetable Carving was organized on 22nd & 23rd February of this year. Mr.Manimaran, Academy of carving, Chennai felicitated the proceedings. To Crown it all the Women's Day was celebrated with much fanfare and gaiety. A felicitation programme was organized in association with JCI, Sivakasi. NCC

Our College has two NCC units, one for girls and the other for boys. They are led by Lt.Brinda Uma Maheswari and Major Sivasubramanian respectively. The cadets of our units have continued to participate enthusiastically in various activities. Cdts.K. Raghuram II B.Com and K. Alaghu Raja, II B.A. History representing the Tamil Nadu contingent participated in the National Integration Camp held in Mysore during October 2011. Cdt. Alaghu Raja took part in the National-level Basic Leadership camp held at Vardha, Maharashtra during December, 2011.

Cdts. R. Sathish Kumar, II B.Sc., Computer Science and T. Aswath Kumar, II B.Sc., Chemistry were among the select 33 of our state's contingent chosen to take part in the Thalsanik camp which is an all-India level leadership camp.
